

### **Art2Art: Dear Evan Hansen Fall 2019 (November - January) Application Preview**

Art2Art: Dear Evan Hansen is a unique and free ArtsConnection Teen Program for visual artists from NYC public high schools to draw inspiration from a hit musical currently on Broadway. Teens will meet fellow teen artists, participate in an interactive workshop, and attend a performance of Dear Evan Hansen on Broadway, which will include a talkback with members of the cast/creative team. Teens will create a piece of art inspired by the musical and their art will be displayed in an online gallery and the Music Box Theatre.

**1. Eligibility:** Art2Art: *Dear Evan Hansen* is a program for students (grades 9-12) currently enrolled in a NYC public high school. We will not be able to consider students who are NOT enrolled in a NYC public high school. We cannot consider former Art2Art: *Dear Evan Hansen* participants at this time. Students who have not previously seen *Dear Evan Hansen* are encouraged to apply.

#### **2. Schedule for Art2Art: Dear Evan Hansen (Fall 2019: November - January)**

**All events are in midtown Manhattan**

1. Workshop: **Tues., November 12 from 4:30-6:30pm**
2. Attend *Dear Evan Hansen* Performance: **Tues., November 19 from 6-10pm**
3. Art due to ArtsConnection: **by Friday, December 6 @ 5pm**
4. Celebration: **Tuesday, January 14 @ 5pm**

**3. Click on Log-In and Apply.** For new registrants this will allow you to set up a profile and see other open applications in Teen Programs. Be sure to include your most accurate contact information in the bio so we can communicate with you. Do not include email addresses or phone numbers that you rarely use.

**4. Check the Open Applications list and start the Art2Art: Dear Evan Hansen Application.** The application asks you a few questions about your availability to attend program dates, your interest in the program, and your experience and interests as a visual artist. We strongly recommend that you read over your answers before submitting your application to ensure they are clear. Here are the questions we ask you to answer on the application:

**5. Save and submit your application.** You can save your application and work on it later if you need to by clicking the **SAVE** button at the bottom of the screen. This is a great tool if you need more time to think about your answers. Just keep in mind that you will have to log in to the Teen Application Portal to complete and submit your application in order for it to be reviewed for the program. Once you submit the application, then you'll receive a confirmation email telling you that we have your application.

**6. Application Timeline.** Applications must be submitted no later than **Sunday, October 13 @ 11:59pm**. All applicants will be notified of their application status by October 18.
